Relevant Objective

- **Objective 5 – Infrastructure**

To maintain and enhance the existing provision of facilities and services, and to ensure appropriate new provision is made for any future developments within the Parish and in surrounding areas.

Community Assets - Policies

- **CA Policy 1: Memorial Hall**

To continue to support the Memorial Hall so that it remains a focal point for the village with appropriate facilities to suit the 21st century needs of the local community.



Community Assets - Policies

- **CA Policy 2: Recreation and Play Equipment**

To support the management committees in maintaining and improving key recreational and green spaces. To encourage and support the provision of additional recreational space for local needs, particularly for junior footballers



Community Assets – Policies contd.

- **CA Policy 3: Preschool provision**

To support the full provision of pre-school education for the needs of all Whittlesford families

- **CA Policy 4: Primary School**

To support the full provision of primary education to meet the needs of all Whittlesford families, including those likely to move into new developments, making maximum use of the William Westley School.



Community Assets – Policies contd.

- **CA Policy 5: Retail**

To support any future proposals that will ensure long term viability of the village shops and post office. Any future proposals in the vicinity of the station, to meet the needs of new residents in the area and commuters, will be favourably supported.

- **CA Policy 6: Licensed businesses**

To support any reasonable plans to maintain all of the current licensed premises as viable businesses

- **CA Policy 7: Footpaths**

To seek opportunities for additional footpaths, including permissive footpaths, in conjunction with landowners and neighbouring parishes
